- a. Dr. Joseph Gillespie Chief Executive Officer:
 - i. Reviewed and discussed with the Board the February 2019 CEO report, previously disseminated to the Board. Discussion included:
 - 1. A current student enrollment of 1,895 with an enrollment goal of 1,880;
 - 2. Indicated ongoing discrepancies between FPPCS and SPD regarding number of SPED students; however, also highlighted steps were being taken to correct SPD's record;
 - 3. Answered related Board questions.

C. American Paradigm Schools CEO

- a. Dr. Margery Covello Chief of Staff of American Paradigm Schools:
 - i. Reviewed with the Board the February 2019 APS report, previously disseminated to the Board. Discussion included:
 - 1. Hiring of a full-time recruiter of teachers;
 - 2. Data/Tech team was providing ongoing support to FPPCS for roster and scheduling plans;
 - 3. Highlighting the late June APS leadership retreat
 - ii. Scott Kramer Chief Talent Officer:
 - 1. Highlighted an increased attendance of APS to job fairs from 18 last year to over 35;

- 2. Indicated goal is to have as few teacher vacancies as possible at APS schools;

- 6. Indicated that 22 teachers were hired through referrals, an increase from 14; and
- 7. Indicated that FPPCS had already begun hiring for the 2019-2020 school year.
