- Do not restrain
- Do not put anything in mouth Notify Certified School Nurse
- For tonic-clonic (grand mal) seizure: Stay with child until fully conscious

- Keep airway open/watch breathing
- Turn child on side

A Seizure is generally considered an Emergency when:

- A convulsive (tonic-clonic) seizure lasts
- longer than 5 minutes
- Student has repeated seizures without regaining consciousness
- Student has a first time seizure
- Student is injured or has diabetes
- Student has a seizure in water Student has breathing difficulties
