WHEREAS, Point Park University ("PPU") has a program to allow for uncertified teachers to become certified (the "Program").

WHEREAS, First Philadelphia Preparatory Charter School ("FPPCS") and PPU desire to enter into a partnership whereby FPPCS may offer uncertified FPPCS staff to become enrolled in the Program, and FPPCS may, subject to budgetary constraints and in the CEO's determination and discretion, pay the applicable tuition to PPU on behalf of those uncertified FPPCS staff, to allow such uncertified FPPCS staff to become certified as part of the Program (the "Agreement").

RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of FPPCS hereby authorizes the CEO, in consultation with the business controller and legal counsel to negotiate the terms of the Agreement and to enter into such Agreement with PPU.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of FPPCS hereby authorizes that the CEO shall, in consultation with the business controller and legal counsel, negotiate and enter into agreements with those uncertified FPPCS staff members, who, subject to budgetary constraints and in the CEO's determination and discretion, become enrolled in the Program as part of the Agreement and who FPPCS paid the tuition for, for the repayment of tuition FPPCS paid on their behalf.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the CEO shall provide to the Board of Trustees of FPPCS regular updates on the progress and expenditures related to the Agreement.
