<u>Handbook Reminders:</u> We want to finish this year with joyous fun filled events, not events that impact school safety; therefore, we are asking for your support in reminding your scholars of the behavior expectations at school. Some examples are:

<u>Athletics:</u> Participation in our athletic program is a privilege. Scholars are students first and athletes second. Grades, attendance (excused and unexcused) and behavior all count toward determining eligibility.

Please finish strong and make sure that your scholar is in school every day.
